## Database of audits

The database of audit reports has been designed as a database containing basic information and links concerning audit reports issued by the EUROSAI members (including where available the report itself). The database was launched in 2015 and its maintenance has been entrusted to Goal Team 3.

To search in the database you can use the search filter.

You have to use an electronic template to upload an audit report. Before uploading a report, please register and fill in the User registration request that is situated at the top right side of the website. Before the first uploading, registration as an authorized user is needed.

# Easy access to the database

1. User registration request – e-mail, password (video tutorial)

<b>Comments</b>	Simplified cost options (SCOs) can bring simplification and may decrease the administrative burden for both beneficiaries and Member State authorities. However, they only constitute a small part of rural development spending during the 2014-2020 period. By basing payments on output, SCOs shift the focus away from invoices but do not increase the focus on results. We found that SCOs can keep the costs of rural development projects under control, but only if set at the right level and based on a fair, equitable and verifiable methodology.

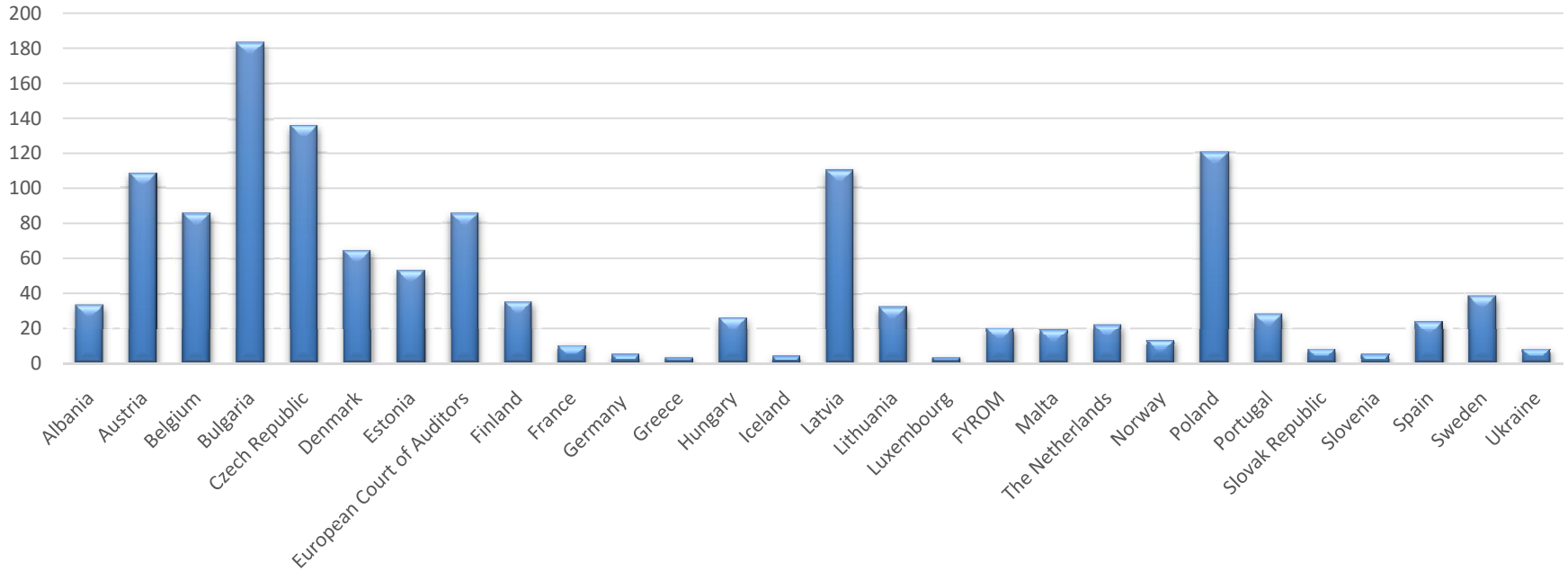

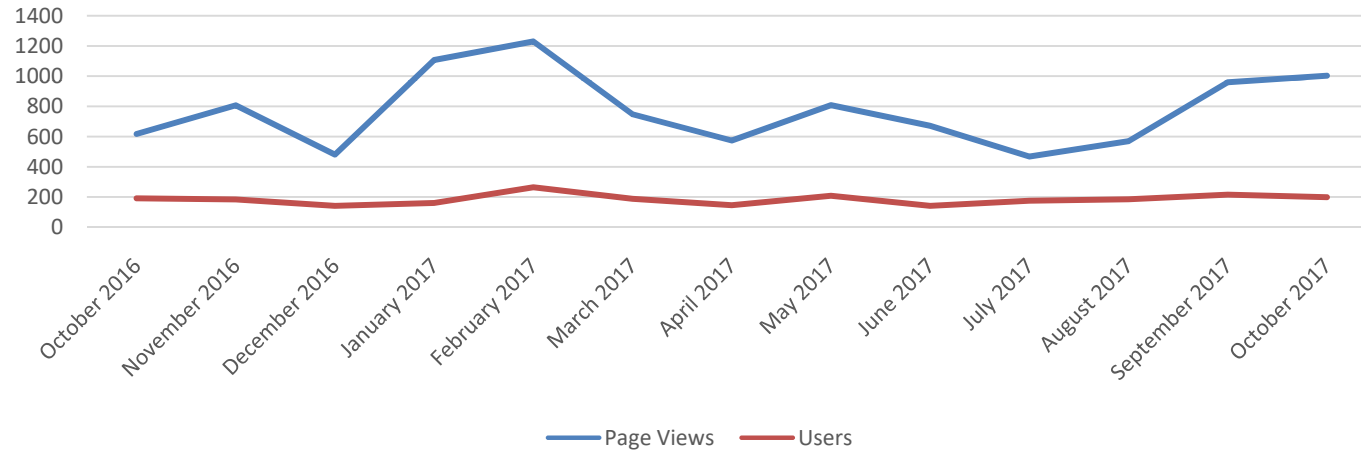
